Conversion to Judaism

Meets Thursday Evenings - 7:00-9:00 p.m.

Orientation – August 8th - 7:00-9:00 p.m.

Classes begin August 15th

*(**Weekly sessions will be offered VIRTUALLY with some in person opportunities offered throughout the year that may rotate between Synagogues & Jewish Community Campus)*

- Acquire an understanding of the basic foundations of Judaism and explore what it means to live a Jewish life.
- A comfortable and engaging forum that introduces participants to central Jewish beliefs, practices, and texts as well as to the history of the Jewish people. Learn about Jewish holidays, prayer, theology, life cycle observances, rituals, customs, ethics, Israel, Torah, Judaism’s view of God and information from the lens of the various Jewish movements. Course includes a 30-minute Hebrew component each week.
- Create Jewish memories by taking part in a “learner’s” Shabbat experience and participating in other holiday celebrations and observances.
- Study with Reform, Conservative, Orthodox and non-denominational Rabbis.
- By November 15th... Each student will select a Rabbinic Sponsor who offers individual guidance and mentorship
